STATE SENATE

The 32nd Senate District includes the following:

Crawford County: Includes the towns of Bridgeport, Clayton, Eastman, Freeman, Haney, Marietta, Prairie du Chien, Scott, Seneca, Utica, and Wauzeka. The villages of Bell Center, De Soto, Eastman, Ferryville, Gays Mills, Lynxville, Mt. Sterling, Soldiers Grove, Steuben, and Wauzeka. The city of Prairie du Chien.

La Crosse County: Includes the towns of Bangor, Barre, Burns, Campbell, Farmington, Greenfield, Hamilton, Holland, Medary, Onalaska, Shelby, and Washington. The villages of Bangor, Holmen, Rockland, and West Salem. The city of La Crosse.

Monroe County: Includes the towns of Adrian, Angelo, Jefferson, Leon, Portland, Ridgeville, Sheldon, Tomah, Wellington, Wells, and Wilton. The villages of Cashton, Melvina, Norwalk, Ontario, and Wilton. The cities of Sparta (ward 19) and Tomah (wards 17, 19-20).

Vernon County: The towns of Bergen, Christiana, Clinton, Coon, Forest, Franklin, Genoa, Hamburg, Harmony, Hillsboro, Jefferson, Kickapoo, Liberty, Stark, Sterling, Union, Viroqua, Webster, Wheatland, and Whitestown. The villages of Chaseburg, Coon Valley, De Soto, Genoa, La Farge, Ontario, Readstown, Stoddard, and Viola. The cities of Hillsboro, Viroqua, and Westby.

Instructions for Circulation of Nomination Papers

Signatures of Electors: Only qualified electors of the State of Wisconsin (at least 18 years old, U.S. citizens who are residents of the 32nd Senate District) may sign nomination papers. Each elector signing a nomination paper must list all of the information required and have not previously signed a nomination paper for another candidate for the same office in the same election. Each elector's municipality of residence must be listed on the nomination paper along with the address, including any street name and number, rural route, number, and/or fire number. Post office boxes are not valid. The circulator may add any missing or illegible information before the papers are filed with the filing officer.

Signature of Circulator: The circulator should carefully read the language of the Certification of Circulator. The circulator must personally present the nomination paper to each signer. The nomination paper may not be left unattended on counters or posted on bulletin boards. The circulator's complete address, including municipality of residence, must be listed in the certification. After obtaining signatures of electors, the circulator must sign and date the certification. A notary is not required.
